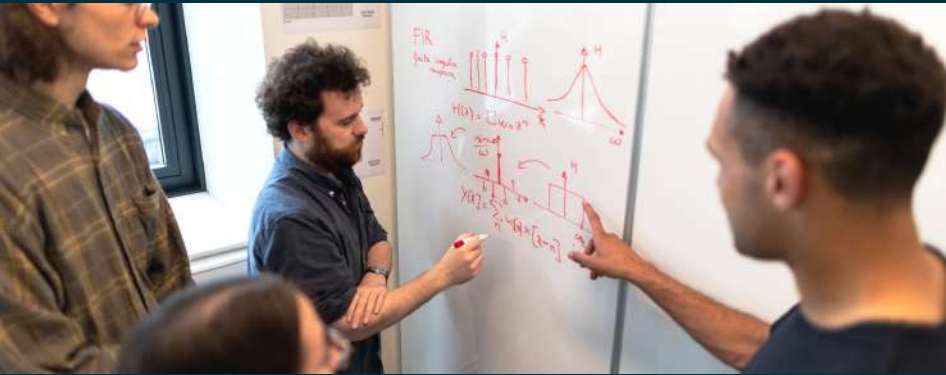

Programme

CoDaS is a joint M.Sc. two years programme in the area of communications engineering and data science, offered by three European Partner Universities: Técnico Lisboa (University of Lisbon), with Aalto University and Grenoble INP Institute of Engineering.

Students enrolling on Técnico Lisboa (University of Lisbon) will study their 1st year at Técnico Lisboa and their 2nd year at either Aalto University or Grenoble INP Institute of Engineering.

Graduated students will be awarded Double Degree Diplomas (i.e., one from each of the universities), plus a Supplement Certificate signed by all Partner Universities recognising the Unite! CoDaS Programme.
